REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Swimmers must be registered for the **SPRING TERM by 5th December**. Places cannot be held after this date as it is imperative that pupils are placed in their correct classes at the start of term. Registration in advance is necessary to allow sufficient time to prepare classes for the commencement of the new term. **You are therefore strongly advised to register 'on time'**. We regret that we cannot accept post dated cheques without prior arrangement. Once a course is booked, refunds will only be permitted under exceptional circumstances when a £5 administration charge will be made.

Guidance for Parents of Children attending Swim School lessons

Please ensure that your child:

- Is supervised in the changing room before and after the lesson. If pupils are under the age of eight parents/carers **must** remain in the Centre and be available if required.
- Attends sessions regularly to ensure that the full benefit of the tuition is received.
- Visits the toilet prior to the lesson.
- Uses the changing room appropriately, ensuring that lockers are used and clothing removed from cubicles immediately.
- Wears a one-piece bathing suit as opposed to bikinis and surf shorts as these hamper movement in the water. **(Swim School kit is available and we would like all members to be proud to wear it)**
- Wears a Swim School swimming cap for hygiene purposes and to avoid excessive head movements caused by hair over the face.
- Arrives on the poolside no more than 5 minutes prior to the start of their lesson where they must sit at their allocated area until the teacher takes the register for that class. (Pre school children to wait as advised at the pool entrance to be collected by their teacher) **Swim School teachers are responsible for children of school age on the poolside only 5 minutes prior to the start of the lesson, for the duration of that lesson and until they leave the poolside. If the pool or fire alarms are activated, the instructor will continue to supervise the children throughout any evacuation to the assembly point where the parent/carer will be reunited with the child. (The assembly point is the pitch adjacent to the far side of the pool)**
